Practicum Position Title: Strength and Conditioning Assistant

Project Duties/Responsibilities:

Crash Conditioning provides training for elite hockey players of all ages. They use intelligent and intuitive coaching based on sports science research in order build great athletes, and provide strength and conditioning, flexibility, movement and motor skills, mindset, nutrition, recovery and injury rehabilitation. Their specialized programs develop strength, endurance and explosive power while managing player readiness and fatigue levels. They address all aspects of the game through individualized training plans.

Practicum students will:

- Observe and learn proper assessment and testing techniques related to cardiovascular fitness (VO2 testing), power output (measured jumps & presses-distance, Kaiser power output-watts,) flexibility (sit & reach, FMS) and strength (squat, clean, bench, pull-ups) for hockey players.
- Learn how to gather results and apply them in order to properly create strength and conditioning programs for each athlete.
- Support coaches on the gym floor. Work with hockey teams and small groups by leading warm-ups, assisting coaches in movement drills and spotting / correction form on strength exercises.
- Identify and recommend methods and techniques during warm-ups, speed, agility, and strength training.
