Note: Completion of the BKin degree is required to be admissible to the final year in Werklund School of Education.

IMPORTANT DEGREE CHECKS

- A minimum of 60 units at the senior level are required; a max of 60 units at the junior level are permitted
- A maximum of 60 transfer units may be applied to the degree; a max of 27 units may be applied towards the core.
- A total of 150 unique units are required to complete the combined BKin/BEd degree. 90 units in years 1 through 3 in BKin and 60 units in years 4 and 5 in Education.
