

Faculty of Kinesiology – Sport and Recreation Facilities Space Assignment and Use Operating Standard

March 27, 2026

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Operating Standard is to:

- 1.1. Outline responsibilities relating to the use of Sport and Recreation Facilities Space, and other Space described in the scope of this Operating Standard, in the Dr. Roger Jackson Kinesiology Complex (i.e., KNA and KNB) and the Olympic Oval.
- 1.2. Identify procedures and principles that are used to assign and manage Space effectivity and efficiently.
- 1.3. Ensure that decisions are made fairly and transparently in accordance with faculty and University strategic and operational plans.

2. SCOPE

- 2.1. This Operating Standard primarily applies to the Sport and Recreation Facilities Space in the Faculty of Kinesiology. It also applies to certain office, storage, meeting, and classroom spaces. See Appendix A for a map of the areas within the scope of this Operating Standard, and Appendix B for a list of bookable spaces.
- 2.2. Other policies and/or agreements may take precedence over this Operating Standard should any discrepancies arise (e.g., the University Space Allocation Policy, Faculty of Kinesiology Academic Space Assignment Policy, Olympic Oval Endowment Agreement).

3. DEFINITIONS

In this document:

- a) “Affiliated Client Groups” means an organization or individual with a formal agreement with the University. This includes Student Union (SU) and Graduate Student Association clubs.
- b) “Allocation” means the distribution of Space to a Unit.
- c) “Assign” means the distribution of Space within a Unit for a particular purpose.
- d) “Booking” means the formal confirmation and authorization of the use of a Space for a specific purpose, date, and time by Kinesiology Operations.
- e) “Client Group” refers to organizations, individuals, or Faculties, internal or external to the University of Calgary who have a Booking.

- f) “Dinos Athletics Club Teams” means University of Calgary Dinos teams that are designated as a club team by the Athletics Department.
- g) “Dinos Athletics Varsity Teams” means the University of Calgary Dinos intercollegiate sport teams that are designated as varsity by the Athletics Department.
- h) “Dr. Roger Jackson Kinesiology Complex” means the KNA and KNB buildings.
- i) “External Client Groups” means an organization or an individual with no affiliation to UCalgary, or faculty, staff and students who are not engaged in University activities or business.
- j) “Facility” means a specific amenity in the Spaces included in the scope of this Operating Standard (e.g. Jack Simpson Gymnasium).
- k) “Faculty Client Groups” refers to Kinesiology Units who are Booking Space for University business.
- l) “Kinesiology Operations” refers to the office within the Kinesiology Facilities and Operations.
- m) “Kinesiology Unit” means an organizational unit within Kinesiology (e.g., Dinos Athletics, Active Living, Olympic Oval, Sport Medicine Centre).
- n) “Space” means an area of Real Property that is owned and/or leased by the University.
- o) “Other Special Events” refer to planned activities, competitions, or gatherings. These events may be internal or external and typically require advance Booking, dedicated space, and additional resources.
- p) “Sport and Recreation Facilities Space” means Space located in the Dr. Roger Jackson Kinesiology Complex and Olympic Oval (as specified in Appendix A).
- q) “University” means the University of Calgary.
- r) “University Client Groups” means any academic, administrative or employee unit of the University who is booking space for university business.
- s) “University Special Events” means key events organized and sponsored by the University (e.g., Convocation, Open House, UCalgary Strong Festival). See Appendix C for University Special Event dates.

4. OPERATING STANDARD STATEMENT

- 4.1. The Dean of Kinesiology has the delegated authority to Assign Space in accordance with Faculty and University strategic plans, initiatives, and applicable UCalgary policies.
- 4.2. Space is a limited resource and will be assigned as effectively and efficiently as possible.

- 4.3. Space assignments are not permanent; they are temporary and subject to review based on changing needs.
- 4.4. Space is not owned by individuals, groups, or current occupants, even if they have obtained or received funding to develop or renovate Space. For clarity, no Kinesiology Unit or Client Group owns Space.
- 4.5. Kinesiology Units are not permitted to transfer or “sub-let” assigned Space to other groups. Client Groups are not permitted to transfer or “sub-let” assigned Space to other groups.
- 4.6. Space is to be used for its intended purpose. Space may only be re-purposed with the approval of the Dean of Kinesiology and following all applicable UCalgary policies and approvals.
- 4.7. Any requests to renovate, remodel, or otherwise alter Space must first be approved in writing by the Kinesiology Unit Director and then submitted to the Director, Kinesiology Facilities and Operations. Requests must be approved by the Dean of Kinesiology before being advanced through all relevant UCalgary processes and procedures.
- 4.8. Generally, the Director, Kinesiology Facilities and Operations, is responsible for overseeing renovation and maintenance projects for Space defined within the scope of this Operating Standard, consistent with all applicable UCalgary policies and processes. At the discretion of the Dean, this responsibility may be assigned to Unit Directors for certain projects.

5. RESPONSIBILITIES

- 5.1. The appropriate Unit Director will be responsible for the day-to-day management and application of this Operating Standard and recognize its potential to have operational, reputational, and fiscal implications for the Faculty of Kinesiology.
- 5.2. The Dean, Faculty of Kinesiology has the approval authority to:
 - 5.2.1. ensure appropriate rigour and due diligence in the development or revision of this Operating Standard;
 - 5.2.2. ensure compliance to other University and Faculty policies and procedures and relevant authority, accountability, and approval frameworks.
- 5.3. The Director, Kinesiology Facilities and Operations has the implementation authority to:
 - 5.3.1. ensure that University staff are aware of and understand the implications of this Operating Standard;
 - 5.3.2. monitor compliance with this Operating Standard;
 - 5.3.3. regularly review the policy and related procedures to ensure consistency in practice;
 - 5.3.4. lead the revision of this Operating Standard when necessary; and
 - 5.3.5. ensure the most up to date version of this Operating Standard is available on the Kinesiology Operations Website.

6. PRIORITY BOOKING ORDER

- 6.1. In general, Space will be booked in accordance with the following priorities for the Dr. Roger Jackson Kinesiology Complex. Specific priority booking order for each bookable Facility in the Dr. Roger Jackson Kinesiology Complex can be found in Schedule 1:

- First priority: University Special Events.
- Second priority: Undergraduate and graduate courses scheduled in the University calendar.
- Third priority: Dinos Athletics Varsity Teams Canada West and U SPORTS games/competitions.
- Fourth priority: Dinos Athletics Varsity Teams practices.
- Fifth priority: Active Living programming and student drop-in times.
- Sixth priority: Dinos Athletics Sport Clubs games/competitions and practices.
- Seventh priority: External Client Groups, Faculty Client Groups, Affiliated Client Groups, University Client Groups.

6.2. There are certain special circumstances concerning the Olympic Oval (see Article 13). In general, in the Olympic Oval, Space will be booked in accordance with the following priorities. Specific priority booking order for the Olympic Oval can be found in Schedule 2:

- First priority: University Special Events
- Second priority: Oval competitions
- Third priority: High performance oval groups
- Fourth priority: Dinos Athletics Varsity Teams practices
- Fifth priority: Dinos Athletics Club Team practices
- Sixth priority: Active Living programs and intramurals
- Seventh priority: Public Skating
- Eighth priority: Speed Skating Clubs
- Ninth priority: External Client Groups

6.3. In the Olympic Oval, during the ice out period, mid-March to mid-July, the first priority for bookings is University Special Events.

7. RESEARCH

7.1. Requests for Space to conduct Kinesiology research (i.e., research led or directly supervised by an academic staff member whose home faculty is Kinesiology) will be accommodated whenever possible. It is understood that previously scheduled Bookings will not normally be altered to accommodate Space requests for research. Kinesiology researchers will not be charged for the use of Space for research activities.

7.2. Requests for Space to conduct non-Kinesiology research (i.e., research conducted by other UCalgary researchers that is not led or directly supervised by a Kinesiology academic staff member) will be considered and accommodated if Space is available. These University researchers will not be charged for the use of Space, other than if there are direct costs incurred by Kinesiology Operations for additional staffing, maintenance, cleaning, etc.

8. BOOKING PROCEDURES

8.1. Bookings must follow the established [Internal Booking Process](#), including deadlines. Priority is forfeited if requests are submitted late.

9. RENTAL FEES AND OTHER COSTS

- 9.1. Space rental fees and other costs of rental will be established and reviewed annually by the Director, Kinesiology Facilities and Operations.
- 9.2. The Director, Kinesiology Facilities and Operations will communicate any changes to Space rental fees to Client Groups providing a suitable notice period, which is aligned with requirements of any applicable Space Use Agreements or other agreements.
- 9.3. Unless otherwise stated, External Client Groups, University Client Groups, and Affiliated Client Groups are responsible for all costs associated with Bookings, including caretaking, labour (e.g., bleacher setup, floor tarping), or similar operational needs. There will be no rental fee for Kinesiology Unit core programming.

10. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- 10.1. In the case of a dispute over a Booking assignment within a Kinesiology Unit (i.e. Active Living, Dinos Athletics, Olympic Oval, Sport Medicine Centre), the Director of the Kinesiology Unit will resolve the dispute.
- 10.2. In the case of a dispute over a Space Assignment or Booking between Kinesiology Units, the Unit Director will provide the Director, Kinesiology Facilities and Operations with a written summary of concerns and a recommended solution.
- 10.3. The Director, Kinesiology Facilities and Operations will apply this Operating Standard to resolve disputes.
- 10.4. If the application of this Operating Standard does not resolve disputes, the Director, Kinesiology Facilities and Operations will seek to achieve a resolution that is accepted by the involved Kinesiology Unit Directors.
- 10.5. If the Director, Kinesiology Facilities and Operations is unable to achieve a resolution, the matter will be forwarded to the Dean of Kinesiology.
- 10.6. At the discretion of the Dean of Kinesiology, the Directors of the Kinesiology Units may be asked to provide more information and/or meet in-person.
- 10.7. The decision of the Dean of Kinesiology is final and there is no appeal process.

11. CANCELLATIONS AND ADJUSTMENTS

- 11.1. Bookings may be cancelled or adjusted at the discretion of the Director, Kinesiology Facilities and Operations if a Space is deemed unsafe and/or if urgent maintenance is required.
- 11.2. Cancellation and Booking changes follow the [Kinesiology Booking Guidelines found here](#).

12. RELEASE OF UNUSED BOOKINGS BY KINESIOLOGY UNITS

- 12.1. Kinesiology Units must release bookings they no longer need a minimum of seven days in

advance.

- 12.2. Failure to release space that is not needed may result in changes to future Space Assignment or other appropriate measures.

13. SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES REGARDING OLYMPIC OVAL

- 13.1. The Olympic Oval must adhere to the Olympic Oval Endowment Agreement which stipulates that its facilities balance usage for the University, high performance sport, and the community.
- 13.2. Key dates, like ice-in, ice-out, and competition calendars will be established by the Oval leadership and management team in May each year and will be communicated to the Director Kinesiology Facilities and Operations.

14. OFFICE SPACE ASSIGNMENT

- 14.1. The assignment of offices for the Academic program is governed by the Academic Space Assignment Policy.
- 14.2. Within their units, the Kinesiology Unit Directors may assign office spaces to staff in accordance with strategic and operational needs.
- 14.3. If, in the assignment of office spaces to staff, Kinesiology Unit Directors wish to renovate, remodel, or otherwise alter Space, the procedure described in article 4.7 of this Operating Standard must be followed.

15. STORAGE SPACE ASSIGNMENT

- 15.1. Kinesiology Operations will assign storage space within the Kinesiology Complex. Requests for storage space can be submitted to Kinesiology Operations to review at kinesops@ucalgary.ca.
- 15.2. Each Kinesiology Unit will appoint a storage lead, who is responsible for keeping an accurate inventory and submitting this to Kinesiology Operations annually.
- 15.3. Occupants are expected to manage the accrual of items over time and use their space efficiently and effectively.
- 15.4. Audits and storage reallocations may be conducted at any time by Kinesiology Operations.

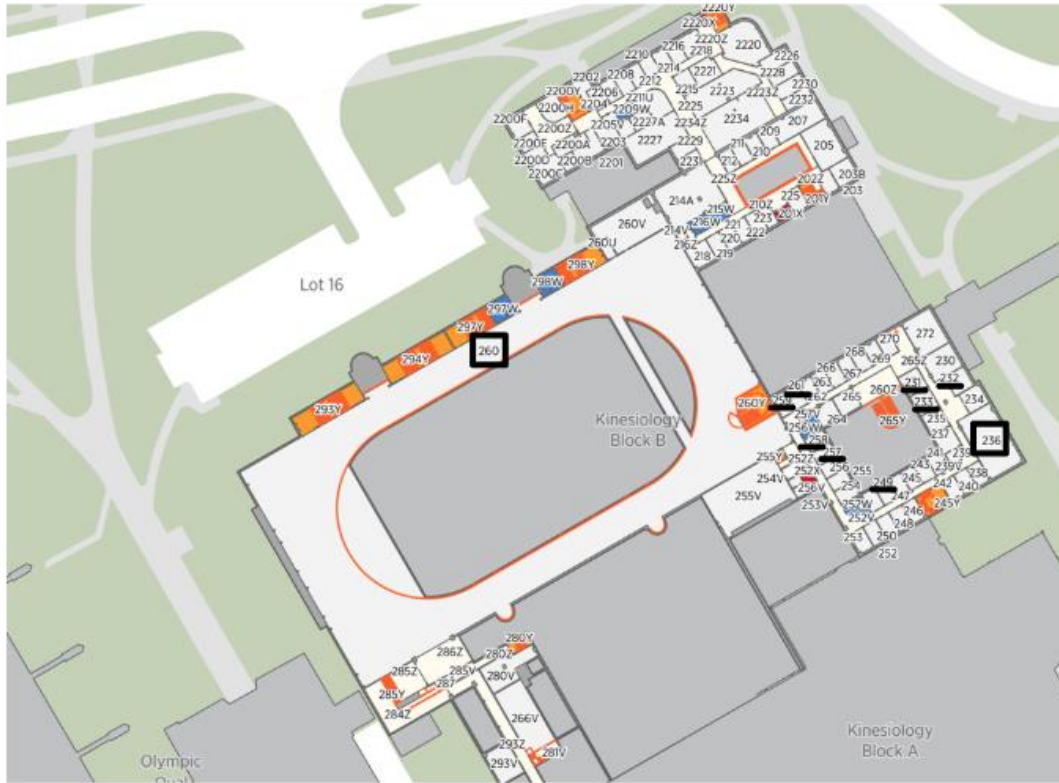

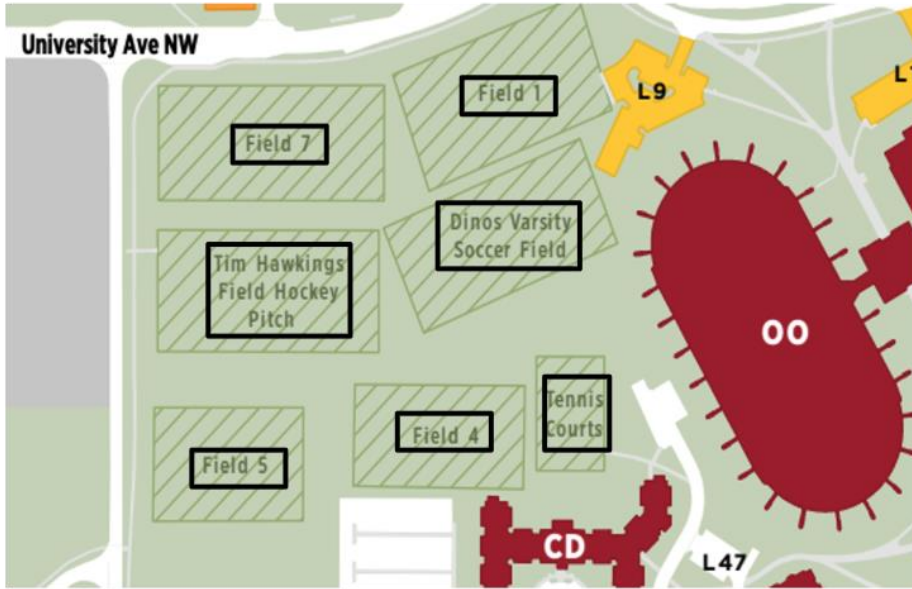

Evening (4:30pm – Close): A minimum 90-minute booking must be available each day in either the Red or Gold Gym between 4:30pm and building close. No more than two of these evening bookings may occur after 8:30pm.

Additional Drop-In sessions may be scheduled throughout the week. Non-sport-specific Drop-In times may be cancelled in favour of other stakeholders, facility repairs etc. provided that, as much as possible, the minimum requirements above are met.
