

Faculty of Kinesiology Presentation Award Application

Kinesiology Presentation Awards acknowledge and encourage thesis-based graduate students to present their research at national and international conferences. **Awards are based on the availability of funding and have a maximum award value of \$1500.00.**

Application Deadlines

A student can apply for one conference per academic year. Applications can be submitted two times per year. If the deadline falls on a weekend it will be moved to the following Monday.

October 1st If Awarded - paid on October 25th

March 1st If Awarded - paid on March 25th

Eligibility Criteria

1. Student must be registered as a full-time graduate student in good standing in the Faculty of Kinesiology Graduate Program at the time of the application **and** at the time of the presentation.
2. Student **must present their work** at a national or international conference within six months of submitting this application (before or after). If the conference occurs after the final thesis has been submitted to FGS the student is not eligible for funding.
3. Students can receive this award once per academic year (i.e., September-August) in program.
4. MSc students are eligible during the first 2 (MSc) or 4 (PhD) years of their program, calculated from their program start date.
5. MSc student can receive a maximum 2 awards during their MSc. Degree. PhD students can receive a maximum 4 awards during their PhD degree.

How to Apply

Students must submit a single PDF document to knesgrad@ucalgary.ca containing:

1. This completed application, signed by the student and their primary graduate supervisor.
2. Documentation confirming that the student's abstract has been accepted for presentation at the conference must be included.
