


Faculty of Kinesiology

Students also have the chance to work on research projects with global leaders such as NASA, the Canadian Space Agency, and the NFL.

Students can pursue either a **Bachelor of Kinesiology** or **Bachelor of Science in Kinesiology**. Bachelor of Kinesiology focuses on applied kinesiology and handson learning. Bachelor of Science in Kinesiology emphasizes science-based courses and research.

Both programs provide practical experience and opportunities to work alongside leading researchers in health, wellness, and human performance.

Expand your education globally with study abroad opportunities tailored for kinesiology students. Norway and Australia are top destinations, offering kinesiology-specific courses at world-renowned institutions. Through semester exchanges or open-credit programs, you can study almost anywhere in the world while earning credit toward your degree.

New group study options, like **Unscrupulous Anatomy and Modern Medicine** in Italy, give students a unique lens on the history and ethics of medicine. Whether you're exploring sport science in Oslo or walking through medical history in Rome, studying abroad builds global perspective, cultural awareness and career-ready skills.

Submit your application

Apply early!

Applications open **October 1.** Apply online and pay the \$125 application fee for students with Canadian credentials or \$145 for students with international credentials.

When you apply to UCalgary, you will get two choices on your application for admission. Be sure to rank your program choices with your most-desired program as your first choice. If you receive an offer to your first-choice program, this is the only offer you will receive.

You can apply or change your program choices until March 1.
